This Newsletter deals with Delegate Credentials and Resolutions.

#### **Credentials**

You must submit all your Credential Forms to the GSU National Office – [info@gsu-ssg.com](mailto:info@gsu-ssg.com) – by **May 31, 2021**. You can find the forms online, here: <https://gsu-ssg.com/en/gsu/governance-of-gsu/triennial-national-convention/gsu-2020-convention>

Here are some key points to remember about the Credentials.

- **A Delegate** is the elected representative of their Local. They will attend convention, participate in the debate, and vote on motions and resolutions. Delegates may stand for election at the GSU Convention. Their expenses will be paid by GSU in accordance with GSU Regulation 4.
- **An Alternate Delegate** does not attend Convention unless they replace a Delegate who cannot attend the convention. However, Locals may choose to send their Alternates to Convention as Observers.
- **An Observer** attends convention for educational or informative reasons. Their Locals may also elect them as an Alternate delegate, which will enable them to replace an Accredited Delegate. Observers are not permitted to participate in the debates or votes. All expenses for Observers are the responsibility of their Local.

Registration information will follow in June 2021.

#### **Resolutions**

Resolutions from Locals **must** be received by the GSU National Office no later than **May 31, 2021**. Resolutions **must** be signed by the local president and sent to the GSU National Office – [info@gsu-ssg.com](mailto:info@gsu-ssg.com) – Resolutions are a very important part of Convention business. *GSU By-Law 12, Section 6*

Up to 100 members  
One delegate – the Local President

101 to 300 members  
Two delegates

301 to 500 members  
Three delegates

501 members and more  
Three delegates plus one additional delegate for every additional 100 members or major fraction thereof
