## **Officers Elections Procedure**

## Note:

- 1. Elections for local officers are conducted by someone outside the local.
- 2. Only members in good standing are eligible to an elected position.
- 3. A member cannot hold more than one elected position, with the exception of the position of secretary and treasurer that can be combined.

## **Procedure**

1. The Chair of the elections will call for nominations 3 times. Each time it will go like this:

Chair: "I call for nomination for the position of ...."

Member 1: "I nominate ..."

Chair: "Is there a seconder for the nomination of ... to the position of ..."

Member 2: "I second"

- [If chair sees that there are no more nominations during the first call out they will proceed as follows] **Chair:** "I now call for a second time nominations for the position of ...."
- [If chair sees that there is no more nominations during the second call out the will proceed as follows] **Chair:** "I now call for a third and last time nominations for the position of ...."
- [If chair sees that there are no more nominations during the third call out they will proceed as follows] **Chair:** "Seeing none, I now close the nominations for the position of ....."
- **2.** In reverse order of nomination, the Chair will ask each candidate if they wish to stand for the position and if they will speak on their behalf for their mini-speech.

Chair: "..., you have been dully nominated and seconded for the position of .... Will you let you name stand?"
Candidate 3: "Yes "[if no, it stops here]
Chair: " will you be speaking on your behalf"
Candidate 3: "Yes "[or no]

- 3. In reverse order of nomination, each candidate will have 1 minute to speak to the audience.
- **4.** Proceed with the election by secret ballot. Simple majority is required.
- 5. Repeat the process for each position.
