#### Parking

The **valet service** is available for \$39 plus taxes and can be charged to the master account. However, space is limited, and availability cannot be guaranteed.

#### Taxi

Participants living in Montreal also have the option to travel by taxi. You must use a municipal taxi service as they are unionized. Please keep your receipts and add them to your expenses claim. GSU does not recommend using Uber/Lyft.
