#### 5. Update – Leave for Union Guidelines

Brother Howard informed National Council that he had a follow-up meeting with Donna Achimov, Assistant Deputy Minister, PSPC regarding 'Leave for Union Guidelines'. Brother Howard stated that these guidelines are status quo. Sister Walton indicated that PSPC had agreed to strike a committee to review this document and that GSU had made recommendations. The committee was composed of the three National Vice-Presidents Sister Walton, (Brothers Cameron, Gale former NVPs) and Brother Cotte (former RVP). Brother Howard stated that he will discuss this issue with Sister Walton as she was part of the committee.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the estimated total cost of \$70,000.00 for the approved event be taken from "Unreserved funds", as it is not an approved line item in the budget for 2018, 2019 and 2020.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the estimated total cost between \$30,000.00 and \$40,000.00 be taken from "Unreserved funds", as it is not an approved line item in the budget for 2015, 2016 and 2017.

Moving/Storage: \$ 15,000.00 or more

Accommodations: \$ 15,000.00

Travel & Transition Expenses: \$ 5,000.00 or more

TOTAL COST: \$ 35,000.00
